Bryant Reese Bowen

Bryant is a Fisheries Biologist for the State of Georgia and is responsible for 13 counties in Middle Georgia. He is responsible for the Oconee and Ohoopie Rivers within those 13 counties. Bryant also supervises the Hugh M. Gillis (here in Laurens County) and Evans County Public Fishing Areas. While these are his primary tasks, Bryant is also involved with the overall management of Region VI Fisheries Management Section. He was born and raised in Tennille, Georgia and graduated from Brentwood Academy. From there, Bryant graduated with a B.S. from The University of Georgia and then a M.S. from The University of Southern Mississippi. Bryant and his wife now live in Blackshear, Georgia with their two boys and are members of the First United Methodist Church of Blackshear.

Fisheries Management

The Fisheries Management Section (FM) manages 500,000 acres of lakes, 12,000 miles of warm water streams and 4,000 miles of trout streams to provide high quality sport fishing. FM surveys fish populations to determine sound management approaches and set regulations. FM also constructs and maintains public boat ramps and fish attractors, investigates pollution and fish kills, assesses environmental reviews, provides technical assistance to environmental agencies, operates fish hatcheries and Public Fishing Areas (PFAs) and sponsors a variety of kids fishing events.

Wildlife Resources Division

The Georgia Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is comprised of six divisions which carryout DNR's mission to sustain, enhance, protect and conserve Georgia's natural, historic and cultural resources. As one of six divisions within DNR, the Wildlife Resources Division (WRD) is charged with conserving, enhancing and promoting Georgia's wildlife resources, including game and nongame animals, fish and protected plants. WRD is comprised of four sections – Game Management, Fisheries Management, Law Enforcement and Nongame Conservation, which regulate hunting, fishing and boat operation, protect nongame and endangered wildlife, provide conservation education and enforce laws for the protection and use of Georgia's natural resources.

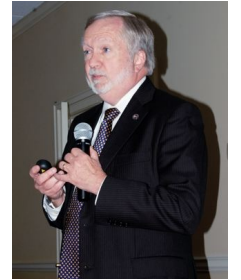
