“Manufacturing Survival in the USA”

Flexsteel Industries, Inc. was incorporated in 1929 and is one of the oldest and largest manufacturers, importers and marketers of residential and commercial upholstered and wooden products furniture in the United States. Product offerings include a wide variety of upholstered and wood furniture such as sofas, love seats, chairs, reclining and rocker reclining chairs, swivel rockers, sofa beds, convertible bedding units, occasional tables, desks, dining tables and chairs and bedroom furniture. Featured as a basic component in most of the upholstered furniture is a unique steel drop in seat spring from which the name “FLEXSTEEL” was derived. The Company has one active “wholly - owned subsidiary; DMI Furniture which is in Louisville, Kentucky and a marketer of residential and commercial office furniture.

The Company’s manufacturing plants are located in Dubuque, Iowa; Riverside California; Dublin, Georgia; Harrison, Arkansas; Starkville, Mississippi and Juarez, Mexico. Distribution Warehouses for Flexsteel are located in Lancaster, Pennsylvania; Huntinburg, Indiana; and Ferdinand, Indiana. The Company has 1300 employees.

The Dublin Plant opened in 1983 with 35 employees and has undergone four expansion programs and is now the largest manufacturing facility owned by Flexsteel. The last expansion in 2003 enlarged the plant to approximately 300,000 square feet to include manufacturing and warehouse space and the maximum employment level was 430 employees.



Marcia Dixon is the General Manager of Flexsteel and has been employed with the company now for 26 years and has served in this role since 1997. Marcia is a graduate of the University of Georgia and graduated from West Laurens High School. She serves the community on various boards and was awarded Woman of the Year as part of the St. Patrick Festival in 2006 and is honored to be a Past President of the Dublin Rotary Club.

She is married to fellow Rotarian, Bob Dixon and they have four children and four grandchildren.
