Rotary clubs celebrate success over Guinea worm in Ghana

Rotary clubs in 14 districts and four countries are celebrating a milestone in the fight against Guinea worm in Ghana and setting their sights on their next target, a rare flesh-eating disease known as Buruli ulcer. Walter Hughes, a member of the Rotary Club of Rocky Mount, Virginia, USA, says Ghana has not had a case of Guinea worm since May 2010. People contract the disease when they drink standing water containing a tiny flea that carries the worm's larvae. The larvae, which can take a year to mature within the human body, cause long-term and sometimes crippling effects. If no cases are reported through May 2011, Ghana will have broken the breeding cycle of the larvae. But a country must go three years without a reported incident for the World Health Organization to officially declare it free of Guinea worm. The parasite also remains endemic in Ethiopia, Mali, and Sudan. Because of the work in Ghana, RI President Ray Klingensmith has appointed Hughes to speak on Rotary's behalf during a World Health Day event in Boston on 7 April. Hughes says he will stress the role that teamwork, both within and outside of Rotary, has played in the Guinea worm
